

BVFD Auxiliary Project Description

The BVFD Auxiliary hosts events at the BVFD Fire Hall to support community engagement and raise funds for the Bamfield Volunteer Fire Department. The Fire Hall is an important venue for public safety programs, as well as community events. When the Fire Hall was built, there were no funds to finish the driveway and sidewalks around the building. Completing these surfaces will provide a safe footing for all those attending the Fire Hall for public safety programs and community events.

A local contractor was invited to tender for the project. He suggested that a larger company would best complete this large endeavour.

J. Robbins Construction Ltd. of Port Alberni was suggested as a good fit for this project. A meeting was held, measurements were taken and a quote received (see budget).
