

Grant-in-aid application for the Centennial Park fire pit celebrating 50 years of Centennial Park

This fire pit, which will replace the present brake-drum fire ring, is intended to express Bamfielders' appreciation for the 50 years of volunteerism that has brought Centennial Park to its present state. And like the dedicated carving of Dancing Bears by Nelson Duncan that inaugurated the park in 1967, challenge the Bamfield citizenry of 2067.

Description:

A 4-foot diameter fire pit, surrounded by a 2-foot high rock wall will be constructed in front of the Centennial Park Memorial Pavilion. The rock wall will be similar to the wall in front of the pavilion. A time capsule will be inserted into the wall and covered with a plaque celebrating the park's 50th anniversary and alerting future Bamfielders to the time capsule, to be open 1 July 2067. The fire pit will be commissioned 1 July 2017, the 50th anniversary of the park.
